<p>COMPETITIVE SEASON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Competitive season begins January 1. ▪ Competitive season traditionally finishes around early May. ▪ All decisions for an upcoming competitive season are finalized at the preceding <i>Fall</i> NCWGA General Meeting. ▪ Follow the <u>NCWGA Membership Packet</u> for member requirements and procedures.
<p>HOSTING A MEET</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ All meets must follow USA Gymnastics Rules and Policies. ▪ For local meets, consult the <u>NCWGA Meet Scheduling Procedure</u>. ▪ For State Championships, see the <u>NCWGA Level 7-10 State Championships Packet</u>.
<p>QUALIFICATION TO STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS</p> <p><i>Qualification Reporting Deadline: March 12</i></p> <p><i>Final Qualification Date: March 18</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Gymnasts may qualify to State Championships from a local meet held in Region I, with a 32.00 minimum All Around score. ▪ Coaches must report any gymnast who is qualified to Level Ten State Championships must be reported to their respective Zone Representatives by <i>Monday, March 12</i>. ▪ Any gymnast who has not yet qualified may compete and still qualify on the final qualifying weekend <i>March 17-18</i>. Coaches must report these qualified gymnasts to their Zone Representative, and register with the State Championship Host by <i>Monday, March 19</i>. ▪ For petition procedures, refer to current <u>USA Gymnastics Rules and Policies</u>. ▪ There is a \$25 per gymnast late fee assessed to clubs for late reports to Zone Representatives and for late registration to Level Ten State Championships.
<p>NORCAL LEVEL TEN STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS</p> <p><i>March 23-25</i></p> <p><i>Hosted by Champion Gymnastics</i></p> <p><i>Stockton Civic Auditorium</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Age groups for Level 10 State Championships are determined by USA Gymnastics in March. There are 4 junior divisions and 4 senior divisions. ▪ Team competition is determined at the completion of the entire meet, by a team's top three or four All Around gymnasts, regardless of age division, with the top three scores per event counting.
<p>USA GYMNASTICS LEVEL TEN REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS</p> <p><i>April 13-15</i></p> <p><i>Hosted by Brown's Gymnastics Las Vegas, NV</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Qualifying score is a 34.00 minimum All Around score at Level Ten State Championships. ▪ For petition procedures, refer to current <u>USA Gymnastics Rules and Policies</u>.
<p>USA GYMNASTICS J.O. NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS</p> <p><i>May 10-13</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Qualification to the USA Gymnastics Junior Olympic National Championships is the Top 7 per age division with a 34.00 minimum All Around score at Level Ten Regional Championships.
